



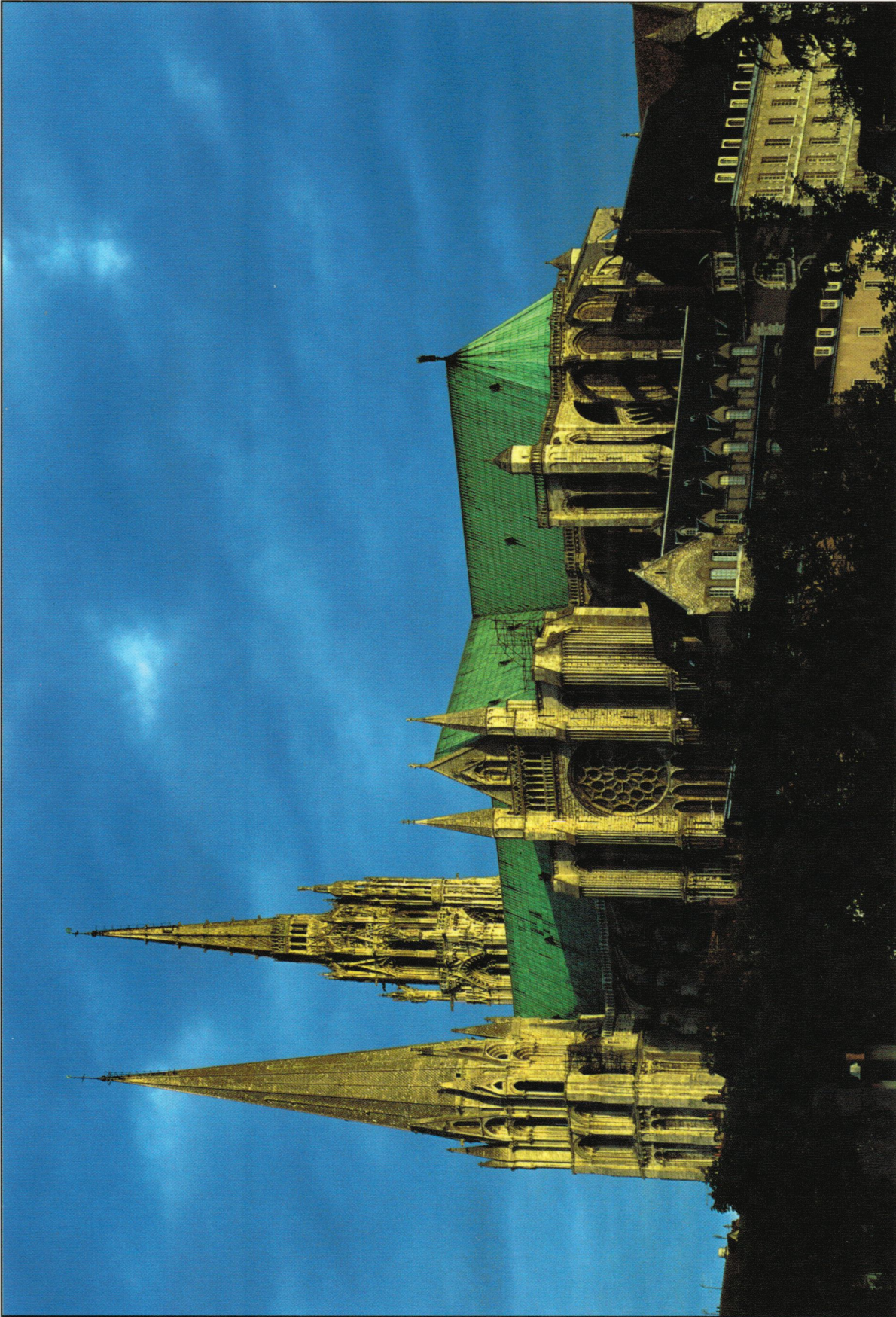
**St. Pantaleon is a church in Cologne, Germany. *Besides attending daily mass, why else do you think people in Cologne went to St. Pantaleon?***
